



Welcome to the 27th Annual North Texas Council of Railroad Clubs Train show season. We are pleased to announce the Fort Worth Train show will be November 12-13, 2011 at the Will Rogers Memorial Center, 3401 W. Lancaster Ave. Fort Worth, Texas. The Dallas Area Train Show will be January 21-22, 2012 at the Plano Centre, 2000 E. Spring Creek Parkway, Plano, Texas.

The show hours and set-up times also remain the same as last year. Due to significant lease price increases at both show locations, table prices were increased by \$10 and the admission price was increased by \$1. Since most of the cost increase in Plano is due to minimum catering requirements, a significant portion of the \$10 table increase will be offset by providing refreshments on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Discounted hotel rate information will be posted on the NTC website www.dfwtrainshows.com, once the information finalized.

The City of Fort Worth has built an 1100 space Parking Garage, along with a 2nd parking garage that is under construction. As a result the City of Fort Worth has implemented a parking fee to offset the cost of the new garages and other continuing improvements. The rates are shown below:

Exhibitors and Vendors may advance purchase multiple day passes at a cost of \$5 per day with IN/OUT Privileges through the Cultural District Parking website: www.culturaldistrictparking.com. The parking booths take both cash and Credit cards. Trailer parking in the Harley Lot is \$3 per day. For more parking information call 1-877-430-7275 or visit the Website. The process for set-up on Friday night and Saturday morning is as follows: Vendors can drive into the hall and unload their merchandise with out paying. Once the merchandise is unloaded the vendor will drive out of the hall and then have to pay to park. The process is reversed on Sunday, after the show closes.
